Knowing God

<u>Jeremiah 24:7</u> And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

<u>Luke 10:22</u> All things are delivered to me of my Father: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and he to whom the Son will reveal him.

<u>Jeremiah 31:3</u> The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee.

What shall we study?

Psalms 8:1 ¶ O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.

<u>Psalms 148:13</u> Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven.

Why the study?

<u>Hosea 4:6</u> ¶ My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

<u>Isaiah 5:13</u> Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because they have no knowledge: and their honourable men are famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst.

What do we want out of this study?

<u>Philippians 3:10</u> That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

<u>Psalms 148:13</u> Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven.

<u>Definition of the word Name?</u>

A word or phrase by which a person or phrase is designated

a primitive word (perhaps rather from 7760 through the idea of definite and conspicuous position; compare 8064); an appellation, as a mark or memorial of individuality; by implication honor, authority, character:--+ base, (in-)fame(-ous), named(-d), renown, report.
